Holiday Social Code of Conduct

The Nebraska-Iowa District of Key Club International sincerely hopes that everyone enjoys this Holiday Social. To insure the comfort of everyone, the following Code of Conduct has been established which each individual is expected to follow.

1. The violation of any rules of the Holiday Social or any state law shall constitute a complete forfeiture of all prepaid conference expenses or registration cost and the violator shall be immediately sent home. NO REFUND of any kind shall be made notwithstanding when the violation shall occur or when the violator is sent home. Transportation home will be the responsibility of the school, sponsoring Kiwanis Club, or the parents of the violator.
2. The consumption and/or possession of any alcohol or non-prescription drugs or narcotics by any person in violation of state law shall constitute a crime and shall be dealt with by the Nebraska-Iowa District immediately and severely. Not only will the violator be discharged from the conference, but also the said violator will be subject to arrest by local law enforcement officers.
3. Smoking or the use of any tobacco product will not be permitted at any time.
4. Attendees are required to attend all sessions and activities in their entirety.
5. A retiring hour of midnight will be observed and enforced. Attendees are expected to be in their own rooms at this retiring hour and they will be expected to remain there. Unnecessary noise at any hour is prohibited.
6. No one member may change room assignments without proper permission from the Holiday Social coordinator.
7. No female (Key Club Member) shall be allowed in the room of any male attendee (Key Club Member) and no male (Key Club Member) will be allowed in the room of any female attendee (Key Club Member).
8. We hereby consent to a warrantless search of the sleeping room occupied by said member at any time, with reasonable suspicion, in the sole discretion of the conference officials.
9. In the event that the undersigned member is injured or becomes ill while in attendance at the Holiday Social, every effort will be made to contact the designated person. In the event that this person cannot be reached, or time does not permit, the undersigned parent or legal guardian hereby consents for Nebraska-Iowa District Officials to seek medical services and for treatment to be rendered if deemed necessary by medical personnel.
10. I understand that the Medical Questionnaire and Emergency Medical Treatment Authorization Form must be signed and notarized and that this form must be signed as indicated before the member can participate or register for any Holiday Social activity.
11. This Code of Conduct is effective as of the time you arrive at the event until you depart.

Infractions of the Holiday Social Code of Conduct Rules will be reported to the conference leaders and adult chaperones. Appropriate action will be taken by them, if necessary, including the dismissal of any person from the conference with notification to the parents, school authorities, and president of the sponsoring Kiwanis Club.
