



NEBRASKA-IOWA DISTRICT KIWANIS 2007-08 INTERCLUB CONTEST RULES

Interclubbing is a means of improving our clubs by allowing Kiwanians to interact and share with each other, and to provide a practical means to form enduring friendships to render service and to build better communities.

Interclubbing is also a useful way for new members to interact with Kiwanians from outside their home club, and to learn more about our purpose, goals, and objectives. Interclubbing is fun.

The 2007-08 District Interclub Contest begins October 1, 2007, and ends September 30, 2008, with the winners being announced at our 2009 Midyear Conference.

RULES:

Clubs with 31 or more members: An interclub is one in which no fewer than **four** members of a visiting Kiwanis club attend the meeting of another Kiwanis club or Service Leadership club. Service Leadership clubs are defined as K-Kids, Builders Club, Key Club, Circle K, and Aktion Clubs.

Clubs with 20 to 30 members: An interclub is one in which no fewer than **three** members of a visiting Kiwanis club attend the meeting of another Kiwanis club or Service Leadership club.

Clubs with fewer than 20 members: An interclub is one in which no fewer than **two** members of a visiting Kiwanis club attend the meeting of another Kiwanis club or Service Leadership club.

An interclub can also be two (2) Kiwanis members accompanied by two (2) members of their sponsored K-Kids, Builders Club, Key Club, Circle K, or Aktion Club to any other club. Interclub members must be in attendance for at least 60% of the time devoted to the meeting of the club being visited.

The visiting club should contact the host club ahead of the meeting so that the host club can plan for their visit.

Interclubs of a Kiwanis club in good standing with the Nebraska-Iowa District and Kiwanis International, and whose official Interclub Report is received by the District Interclub Chair prior to the deadline established by the district, will accrue points according to the following rules and guidelines:

1. The interclub contest-scoring sheet (copy attached) must be completed and received by the District Interclub Chair by **November 15, 2008**. Any entry received after this date will not be scored and included in the contest.
2. Points:
 - a. Interclub with Kiwanis clubs or Service Leadership clubs within your division: 10 points each
 - b. Interclub with Kiwanis clubs or Service Leadership clubs outside your division, but within the Nebraska-Iowa District: 15 points each
 - c. Interclub at Division Council Meetings: 10 points each
 - d. Interclub with clubs outside the Nebraska-Iowa District: 15 points each
 - e. Interclub at Midyear Conference: 25 points
 - f. Interclub at District Convention: 25 points
 - g. Interclub at International Convention: 25 points
 - h. Interclub at International President's Visit: 20 points
 - i. Bonus points when the visiting club presents the program: 5 points
 - j. Interclub at the Governor's Official Visit: 10 points
 - k. Add one (1) additional point for each member over the number required who attend, and add one (1) additional point for each nonmember spouse who attends. For example, if six (6) members attend a Division Council meeting, credit 12 points.
3. Bonus Points: Add 25 points if the club has visited each club within its division at least once.
4. Additional Bonus Points: Add 25 points if the club has visited each club within its division at least twice.

AWARDS:

Each club accruing a minimum of 250 points will receive a recognition award. In addition, the following awards will be presented:

- a. Club with the most points in each division
- b. District winners, according to the following schedule of club membership size:

Coral Section:	Fewer than 30 members
Emerald Section:	30-45 members
Ruby Section:	46-75 members
Diamond Section:	76 or more members
